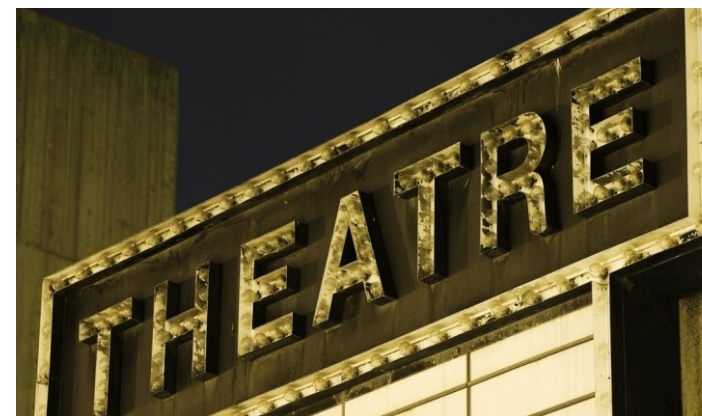


Year 5 Trips 2025—2026
