

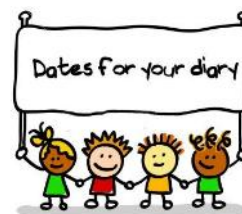

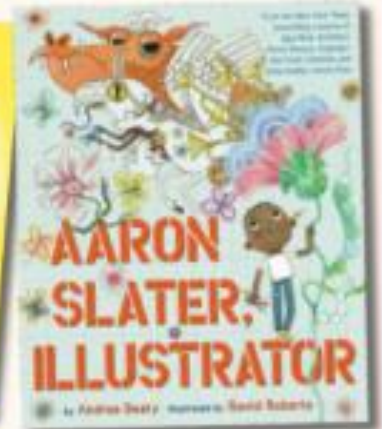
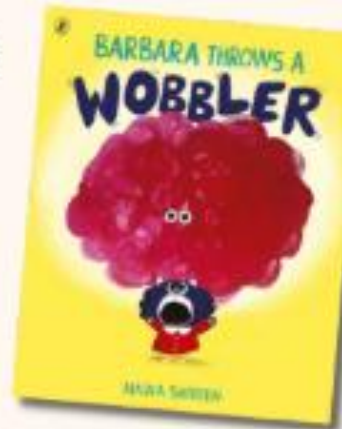
# The STORY PROJECT
