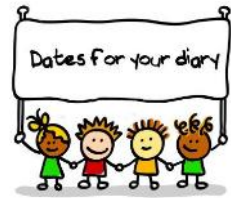

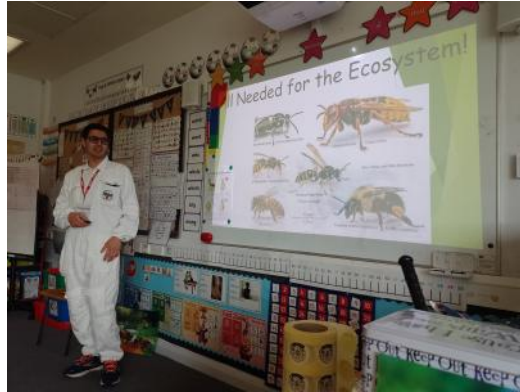

ParentPay

Arbor

You will have received an email from Arbor that will provide information about how to set up your Arbor account. The username will be your email address you will be guided to set up a password. Arbor can be accessed either via the Parent Portal (web page) or the Parent App, whichever you choose. Once registered on Arbor, you will see new trips and clubs and is where you will be able to sign up for clubs and make any future payments.
