

# NEWSLETTER



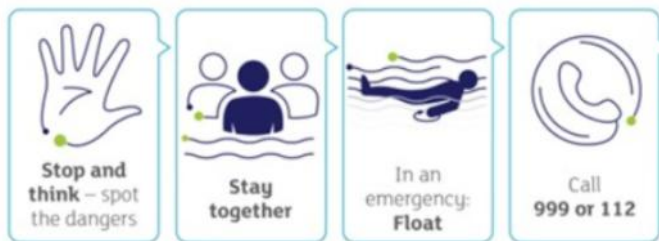
This has been another very busy week, filled with exciting opportunities and memorable experiences for our children.

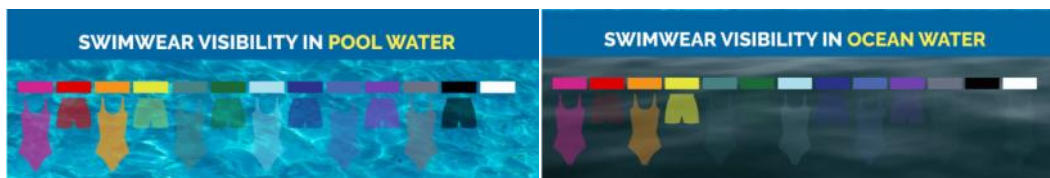

This week's theme was **"The Moon,"** and these are some of the wonderful artworks our students submitted to NASA.



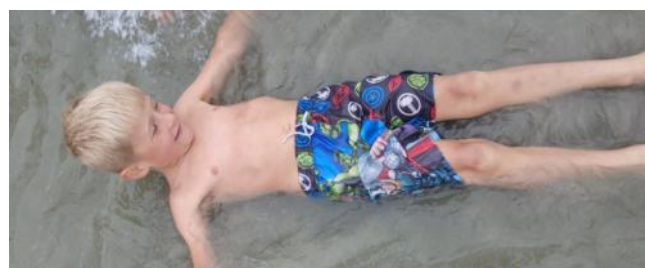
