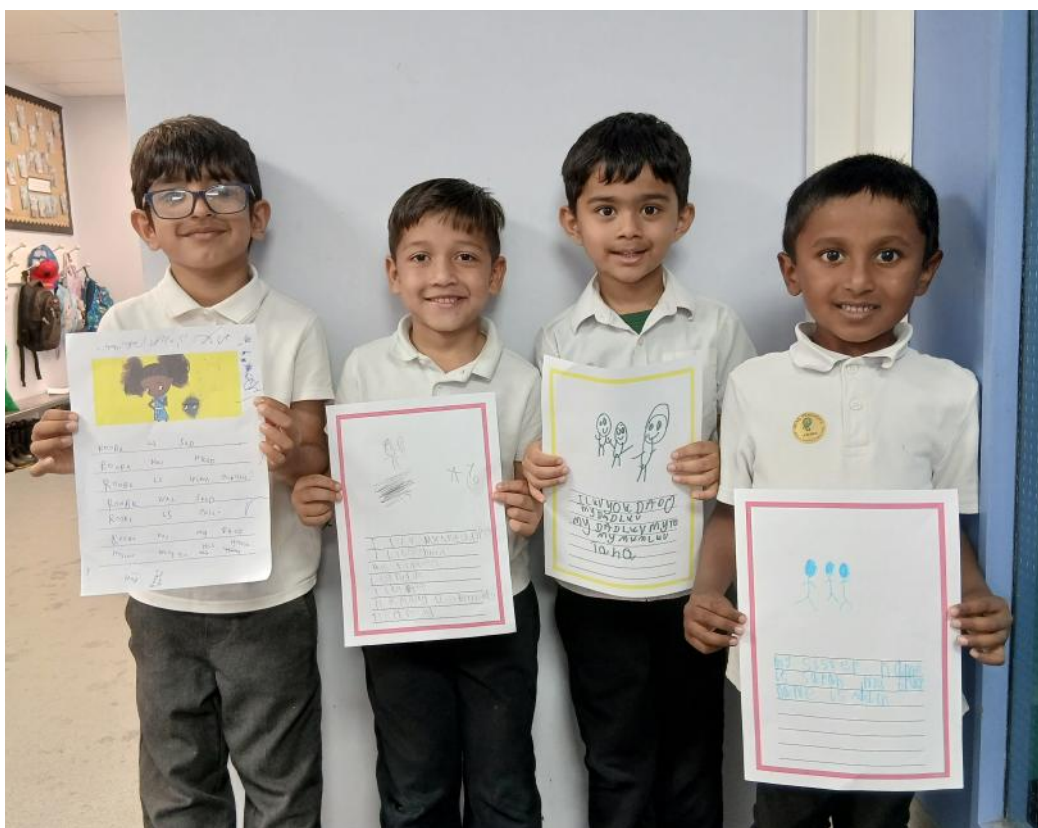

The show was very entertaining, especially our presenter, Brian! All the performers did a great job. The results will be announced during the final assembly.

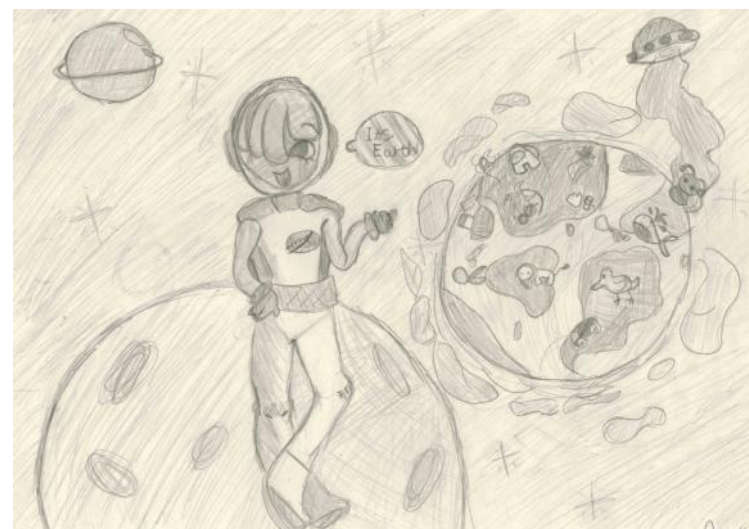
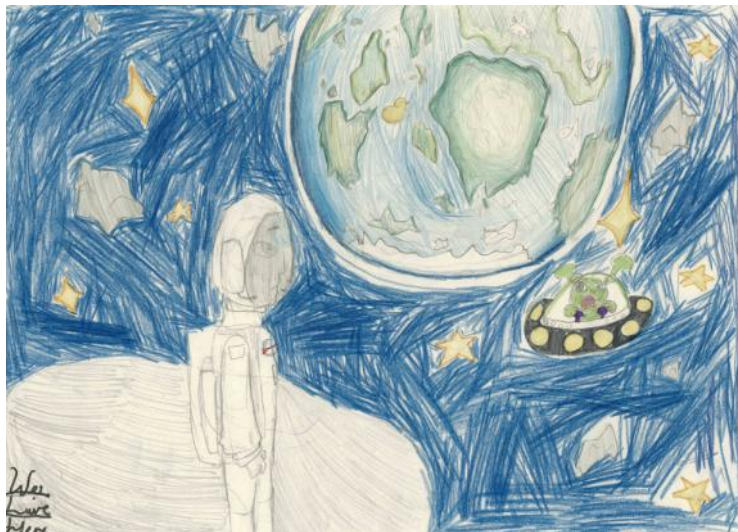

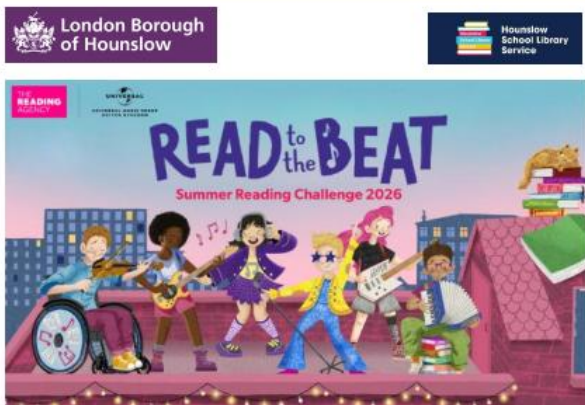


Year 5 had their sports day this week. Well done to everyone for taking part, they had a fantastic time competing against each other!
